1. Do I have to be called to preach to attend CBBI?

No, our classes are meant to be beneficial to all Christians regardless of whether or not they are called to preach. This is one major difference between CBBI and most Bible colleges. Most Bible colleges place little emphasis on teaching the Bible and instead teach more general biblical topics and focus more on how to run a ministry. There is nothing wrong with this but it is not the focus of CBBI. Our focus is on teaching the Bible to anyone who wants to learn.

2. Do you allow women to take classes?

Yes we do. Women are able to take classes and complete degrees at every level (Associate, Bachelor, Master and Doctorate).

3. What is my financial commitment when I apply for enrollment?

We individually price our classes. This means that you only pay for the classes you actually take and when you decide to take them. We do not require you pay for an entire semester or year at one time. Each class costs \$30 and you may buy as few or as many at one time as you so desire.

4. Do you accept transfer credits from other schools?

Yes, but each class is evaluated to determine whether or not it will be accepted for transfer. There is no guarantee that a class you have previously completed will transfer.

5. I am a pastor or Sunday School teacher and have recently taught the book of X in my class. Will you accept that as transfer credit?

No. Although we understand that you may have extensive experience studying and teaching a particular book of the Bible our credits are given based on study completed as part of an established Bible College or Institute program.

6. Do you give "life experience" credit?

No. Our degrees are in recognition of academic completion.

7. I already have a Bachelor's degree from another school. Am I able to enroll directly into the Master of Theology program?

Possibly. We will evaluate the degree you hold and make the determination. You may be required to complete one or more "catch-up" classes depending on the area of study for your undergraduate degree.

8. I already have a Master's degree from another school. Am I able to enroll directly into the Doctor of Theology program?

See the answer to question 7.

9. I am a missionary in a foreign country and would like to use your school's materials to start and run a Bible Institute on my mission field. Is this possible?

Yes! Please contact the Dean for information.

10. I want to attend your school but finances are a problem for me. What do I do?

Contact the Dean. We have a process for handling this type of situation.
